In times of crisis, thousands of people in our community are provided with shelter, food and water, home repairs and counseling

Meeting Basic Needs:

244 people received the support they needed through a 24-hour crisis hotline, educational services, and support groups.

Addressing Family Violence:

2,891 individuals have gained independence through educational and social programs, in home aide and other personal services.

Fostering Independence in the Elderly & Persons with Disabilities:

2,813 residents received diabetes management and health information, and 64 men were provided with help to recover from addictions.
