Each year, a review committee appointed by United Way's Board of Directors evaluates funding requests and presents recommendations, which the Board votes on every April.

Eric joins current trustees Chad Barbour, Director of Student Activities for Cumberland County Schools, and Tom J. Keith, founder of Tom J. Keith & Associates. Together, they bring a wide range of experience in education, business, and community leadership.

The Youth Growth Stock Trust continues to serve as a lasting legacy to Robert Short's vision. Through annual grantmaking, it supports dozens of programs and initiatives that help local youth reach their full potential.
