As we reflect on the past year, I want to pause and thank you. Your faithful generosity has fueled real and lasting change in Cumberland County. Because of you, lives have been touched, families strengthened, and futures made brighter.

Together, we've accomplished remarkable things:

**Every Child with a Book** – In partnership with Cape Fear Valley Health and Womack Army Medical Center, we made history by ensuring every child born in Cumberland County receives their first Dolly Parton Imagination Library book before they leave the hospital. To our knowledge, we're the only county in North Carolina covering 100% of newborns.

Cumberland County Literacy Council Launch – United Way brought together leaders from education, government, libraries, and nonprofits to form the Literacy Council. Our first year alone, we are on track to:

- Recruit and mobilize 100 Literacy Ambassadors
- · Launch 200 new or enhanced literacy programs
- Serve more than 3,000 children with vital literacy resources

These efforts are breaking cycles of illiteracy and opening doors to brighter futures.

**Annual Meal Packing Event** – This year, 560 volunteers from 56 businesses came together to pack 71,160 meals for hungry people across Cumberland County. This incredible effort shows the true power of neighbors helping neighbors.

Strengthening Community Impact – From providing food and shelter to families in crisis, to ensuring seniors live with dignity, United Way programs have touched 1 in 3 people in our community this past year.

None of this would have been possible without your partnership. Your contributions make you more than a donor–you are a cornerstone of change. You are helping to build a stronger, healthier, more compassionate Cumberland County.
