	Unload City of Fayetteville Truck	Volunteers will assist with unloading tents, tables, and chairs from City of Fayetteville Truck. Requires heavy lifting. (Volunteers will need to arrive at 7:30 am and wear comfortable shoes & weather appropriate clothing)	
	Event & Tent Setup	Volunteers will help organizations unload their material from cars/trucks and/or assis with set up as needed. (Volunteers will need to begin arriving at 7:30 am. Se up must be complete by 8:45 am and wear comfortable shoes & weather appropriate clothing) Client Check-In Volunteers will meet and welcome clients in line to receive service These volunteers will go over a structured set of questions on the Check-In Form. They will provide a wristband to enter service gate and also ticket for meal. (Volunteers will need to arrive at 7:30 am and wear comfortable shoes & weather appropriate clothing) Navigators are stationed in the client check-in area. They will help clients navigate throughout the event. They will escort guests to the areas where they can get services and appointments. Navigators will remain with client from the time the client checks in until check-out. (Volunteers will need to arrive at 8:30 am and wear comfortable shoes & weather appropriate clothing)

	Client Check-Out Volunteers	The Client Check-Out Area is the final stop for clients before they obtain a bag me from Second Harvest Food Bank. Check-Out Volunteers work one-on-one with clients before they leave to ensure they have received the services that they were seeking. Also, Client Check-Out Volunteers collect the Intake Forms from the clients and ensures that they are complete before the client receives a ticket the Second Harvest Food Bank meal bags. (Volunteers will need to begin arriving 8:30 am and wear comfortable shoes & weather appropriate clothing)	
	Food Server	Serve food and interact with guests while they receive their lunch. Volunteers will collect clients' tickets. (Volunteers will need to arrive at 10:30 am and wear comfortable shoes & weather appropriate clothing)	
	Clean Up Crew	Assist in cleaning up areas (trash, etc.) during and after the event. (Volunteers will need to begin arriving at 8:30 am and wear comfortable shoes & weather appropriate clothing)	

	Volunteers will help break down the event including reloading City of Fa truck. This position may require lifting and moving heavy objects. (Voluneed to arrive at 12:00 pm and complete by 3:00 pm and wear com shoes & weather appropriate clothing)
