The Youth Growth Stock Trust Grants \$301,257 to Benefit Cumberland County Youth

Fayetteville, NC – The United Way of Cumberland County Board of Directors has approved the 2017 allocation of \$301,257 in grants from the Youth Growth Stock Trust (YGST). Every spring, the YGST provides grants to local programs, initiatives and scholarships that specifically benefit Cumberland County youth.

Cumberland County organizations and schools spend extensive time preparing their proposals for meaningful programs and resources to help youth become successful in their educational pursuits and beyond. This year, the YGST Grants Committee received 60 proposals, requesting approximately \$900,000.
